Established in 1997 at the WSU School of Medicine by the Arab and Chaldean American Physician and Medical Students Fund Committee, the Ibn Sina Endowed Scholarship has recognized Arabs' and Chaldeans' pivotal contributions to medicine, while providing the necessary funds to assist medical students with their financial needs. Preference for the scholarship is given to members of the National Arab American Medical Association (NAAMA).

Ibn Sina, also known as Avicenna, (908-1037 A.D.) was a precocious and prolific scholar and physician. He generated at least 450 written works, nearly half of which survive today. His scholarship had the greatest impact on the canons of medicine and philosophy, but his curiosity led to contributions in many other fields including mathematics, theology, physics and poetry.
