Your Stay ...

Savoy Le Grand Hotel, Marrakech



Located in Hivernage area, this family-friendly hotel in Marrakesh is a 15-minute walk from most famous sites such as Place de la Jeunesse and Palais des Congrès. Menara Gardens and Koutoubia Minaret are also less than 2 km away.

All of the hotel's 368 rooms have charming features such as bathrobes and comfortable slippers, as well as convenient amenities such as refrigerators and coffee makers. You will find free Wi-Fi internet access and balconies or patios, as well as flatscreen TVs with cable channels.

The hotel offers many amenities such as restaurants, lounges and outdoor and indoor pool. The SAVOY SPA offers a relaxing moment in a space that features saunas and jacuzzi fragranced with infused eucalyptus, hammams with rituals inspired by Moroccan beauty rituals and various massages with carefully selected and pure oils.

Your social package includes a stay at the Savoy Le Grand Hotel for 5 nights including breakfast. Rooms are available as single or double occupancy. Accommodation for children under the age of 12 can be arranged with an extra bed in an adult room.

It is hotel policies in Morocco that only one child between 4 and 12 years of age can stay with parents in one room with an extra bed. For more than one child it is best to consider connecting rooms or a junior suite.

Afternoon Orientation Tour by Caleche (Horse Drawn Carriage)

The Koutoubia Mosque, sister tower to Seville's Giralda, the minaret of which has become the symbol of the city. **The Bahia Palace** (19th century), a splendid Moroccan Palace, covered with marble, gold and multicolored onyx. It boasts a beautiful indoor garden planted with orange trees and fabulous lounges.

The delightful *Majorelle's Botanical Gardens* are planted with giant bamboo, yucca, papyrus, palm, cypress and banana trees, philodendrons and bougainvilleas.



Afternoon Walking Discovery of the Souks and Djemaa El Fna Square

You'll experience the daily commercial life of the Medina as your guide leads you through the labyrinthine Souks, truly get to know both the people and the country of Morocco, and more.

The Souks of Marrakesh are certainly the most colorful and the most lively in Africa. The different trades are grouped by services they offer: The Dyers, the Blacksmiths and fabric sellers.

Your journey ends at the renowned Djemaa El Fna square, a popular entertainment area where at the end of the afternoon, storytellers, snake-charmers and dancers appear to entertain the crowd in a scene that is pure street theatre.

EXCLUSIVE BEDOUIN FEAST AT THE MARRAKECH PALM GROVE

In a private and exotic part, a Bedouin experience will be set up specially for NAAMA party, very much in "the middle of nowhere".

Guests will be greeted by 'Blue' men with lit torches, bands of Moroccan folk dancers and singers, and much more. There will be a big bonfire during the evening to add to the ambiance.

The dining area in stylish Bedouin tent will be fully equipped with carpets, tables, comfortable seating and Moroccan crockery. Casablanca (June 28 - 29, 2020)
