

Formerly known as Constantinople, Istanbul is the largest city in Turkey, serving as the country's economic, cultural, and historic hub. The city straddles the Bosphorus strait, lying in both Europe and Asia, and has a population of over 15 million residents. Istanbul is the most populous city in Europe and the world's fifteenth-largest city.

The city served as an imperial capital for almost sixteen centuries: during the Roman/Byzantine period, Latin, Byzantine, and Ottoman empires. The city played a key role in the advancement of Christianity hosting four of the first seven ecumenical councils its transformation after becoming the seat of the Ottoman Caliphate in 1517.

Over 13.4 million foreign visitors came to Istanbul in 2018, eight years after it was named a European Capital of Culture, making it the world's eighth most visited city.

Istanbul is home to several UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Old City Tour and Dinner

The Hagia Sophia

Constructed three times in the same location, it is the world's oldest and fastest-completed cathedral. With its breathtaking domes that look like hanging in the air, monolithic marble columns and unparalleled mosaics, is one of the wonders of world's architecture history. The Hagia Sophia has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1985 as a section called the Historic Areas of Istanbul.

The Blue Mosque

The Blue Mosque (Sultanahmet Camii) is an historical mosque in Istanbul. The mosque is known as the Blue Mosque because of blue tiles surrounding the walls of interior design. The Mosque was built between 1609 and 1616 years, during the rule of Ahmed I. it also comprises a tomb of the founder, a madrasa and a hospice.

Topkapi Palace Museum

Topkapi Palace was not only the residence of the Ottoman sultans, but also the administrative and educational center of the state. Initially constructed between 1460 and 1478 by Sultan Mehmed II, and expanded upon and altered many times throughout its long history, the palace served as the home of the Ottoman sultans and their.

The coastal area of Beşiktaş, where Dolmabahçe Palace is located, is an area that has been the scene of shipping activities in the past as one of the bays of the Bosphorus. Although the official residence for Sultans was Top-kapı Palace, the "dolmabağçe" region became one of the preferred places to visit and has been used as a royal garden belonging to the sultan and the dynasty. Dolmabahçe Palace, became the administrative center of the late Ottoman Empire replacing Topkapi Palace during the reign of Sultan Abdülmejid (1839-1861). It is one of the most magnificent symbolic structures of the Ottoman Empire's changing 19th century identity.



Antalya
