There are so many reasons why you should join our convention this year, just go through these pages and explore them for yourself. We are certain you will enjoy.

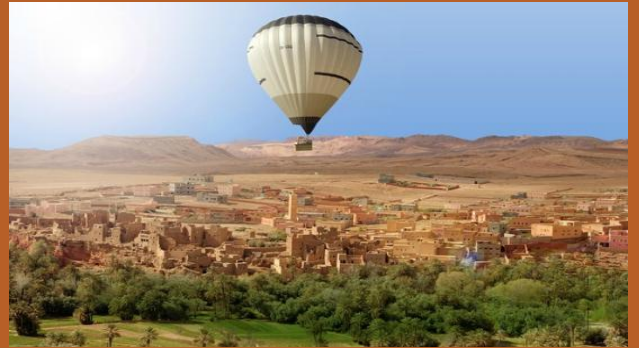

## Radisson Blu Hotel, Marrakech Carré Eden



Set in the heart of Marrakesh, the Radisson Blu welcomes visitors to the vibrant Gueliz quarter. A location in the newly built Carré Eden complex gives easy access to the complex's internationally recognized stores and restaurants as well as to trendy nightlife nearby and steps away from the Hivernage neighborhood.

Designed by famous architect Imaad Rahmouni, this modern hotel features a beautiful lobby, patio, and restaurant. It's a striking contrast to the city's historic quarter located just 10 minutes away, where you can explore the Djemaa El-Fna square and traditional souks.

Its 193 rooms and suites feature a soothing, contemporary style created by designers Lotfi Sidi Rahal and Meriem Benkirane. The on-site restaurant, lounge and bar create a unique open venue, where you can sample regional delights or international selections like tapas and sushi.

The hotel's leisure facilities include a spa, a fitness center and an aquarium swimming pool surrounded by a spacious patio with sunbeds.

Your social package includes a stay at the Hotel for 5 nights including breakfast. Rooms are available as single, double, or triple occupancy. Accommodation for children under the age of 12 can be arranged with an extra bed in an adult room.

# Your Tours ...

## Afternoon Tour by Caleche (Horse Drawn Carriage) to the Majorelle Garden

The Majorelle Garden was designed by the French artist, Jacques Majorelle (1886-1962). As a young aspiring painter, Jacques Majorelle was sent to Morocco in around 1917 to convalesce from a serious medical condition. After spending a short time in Casablanca, he traveled to Marrakech and fell in love with the vibrant colors and street life he found there. After traveling around North Africa and the Mediterranean, he eventually decided to settle permanently in Marrakech.

During his lifetime, Majorelle earned a reputation as a celebrated Orientalist painter. The special shade of bold cobalt blue, inspired by the colored tiles he had seen around Marrakech and in Berber burn-houses, was used extensively in the garden and its buildings and is named after him, bleu Majorelle—Majorelle Blue. Prior to his death, Majorelle patented the color which carries his name.

In 1931, he commissioned the architect, Paul Sinoir, to design a Cubist villa for the property. Gradually, he purchased additional land, extending his holding by some 10 acres. In the grounds around the residence, Majorelle began planting a luxuriant garden which would become known as the Jardins Majorelle (Majorelle Garden). The garden became his life's work and he devoted himself to developing it for almost forty years.

The garden and villa were rediscovered in the 1980s, by fashion designers, Yves Saint-Laurent and Pierre Bergé who set about restoring it and saving it. The pair owned the villa until 2008. After Yves Saint Laurent died in 2008 his ashes were scattered in the Majorelle Garden.

## Afternoon Walking Tour of Old Marrakesh

Starting with a visit to **The Bahia Palace** (19th century), a splendid Moroccan Palace, covered with marble, gold and multicolored onyx. It boasts a beautiful indoor garden planted with orange trees and fabulous lounges.

The palace was first begun by Si Musa, grand vizier of Alaouite sultan Muhammad ibn Abd al-Rahman, in 1859 and then continued and expanded by his son Si Ba Ahmed ibn Musa, grand vizier of Sultan Moulay Abdelaziz between 1894 and 1900.

The palace is most famous for its decoration. Its walls feature stucco carved with Arabic inscriptions, geometric patterns, arabesques, and muqarnas. Its floors are paved with marble and zellij tiles. Among its most famous elements are the cedar-wood ceilings painted with colorful floral patterns, along with the carved and painted wooden canopies of major doorways.



The Souks of Marrakesh are certainly the most colorful and the most lively in Africa. The different trades are grouped by services they offer: The Dyers, the Blacksmiths and fabric sellers.

Your journey ends at the renowned **Djemaa El Fna** square, a popular entertainment area where at the end of the afternoon, storytellers, snake-charmers, and dancers appear to entertain the crowd in a scene that is pure street theatre.

## Full Day Visit to the Berber Villages and Agafay Desert

The official name of Berber tribes in Morocco is actually Amazigh, a word which means “free people.”

The Amazigh people are incredibly friendly. Whether you visit one of the wealthiest family or one of the more modest ones, they will make it a point to welcome you with tea, snacks, and to show you around their house. On some occasions, they will even show you their best dresses and ask you to try them on, and then pose for photos with you. You'll be able to appreciate the gorgeous landscape of the Atlas Mountains and you will be visiting various villages, with a chance of encountering the Amazigh people.

The Agafay Desert is one of the country's few remaining stretches of true desert, and it's a popular spot for tourists looking to experience a taste of the Sahara. Horseback riding or quad bike riding are a few other activities that can be arranged while you visit the desert as well as spending time at the Berber Villages where you will have lunch “local style”.

## Dar Yacout



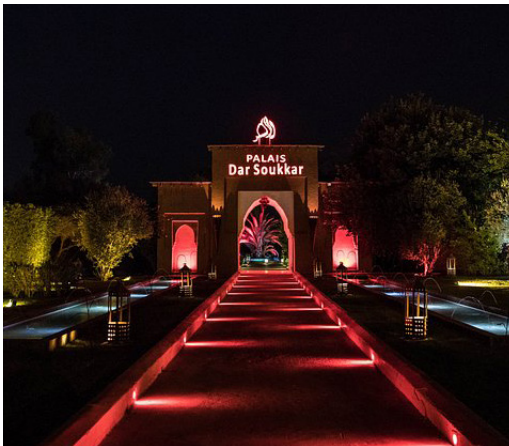

## Palais Sukkar



A mythical place steeped in history. It was built in the 16th century on an old sugar factory, some remains of which still exist today. In 2004 the palace was renovated to host prestigious private events such as the Marrakech International Film Festival, the Marrakech Du Rire or the Dior evenings to finally launch its charming and unmissable dinner show to the wider community in 2016. Located just 10 minutes from Djema el Fnaa Square, the Palace is a lighthouse for the red city.

The aim of the Palace is to sublimate the great culinary traditions of Asia, the world and Morocco by blending history, nature and the exciting adventure of creation.

## Palais Soleiman



Palais Soleiman is located into an old palace of Marrakech, North Medina. Near Riad Aguaviva and Bab El Khemis.

This was once the place from the lords of Marrakesh: The Caïd Layadi. Palais Soleiman restaurant offers an extraordinary architectural example of preservation: ceilings carved and painted wood, antique zellij and majestic spaces.

Everything here exudes elegance and sophistication. Food wise, Driss Segueni offers superb cuisine composed of original Moroccan recipes. This restaurant offers closed menus of the most Traditional Moroccan cuisine with belly dancing show and Traditional Music in an incredible oriental ambient.

#### **December 24, 2022**

Arrive to Barcelona and check in at the Catalonia Exiample 1864 Hotel

#### **December 25, 2022**

Breakfast and departure to explore Barcelona. Enjoy a ride to the hill of Montjuic, site of the 1992 Olympic Games and the 1929 International Exhibition and one of the most beautiful views of the city.
