On February 6th, a disastrous earthquake hit Syria and Turkey, leaving thousands dead and hundreds of thousands more injured and homeless. In response, the NAAMA Foundation launched an emergency relief appeal on February 7th to support the victims through the direct aid UNICEF is providing on the ground. As of today, thanks to our generous and compassionate donors, \$127,483 has been raised, and UNICEF has already received \$120,000 of these funds. The Foundation urges you to keep donating, as the impact of the disaster has affected millions of Syrians who were already suffering from displacement and very poor economic circumstances.



NEWS


The Saint Louis Chapter is planning an outdoor event/party for the summer. The proceeds will be dedicated toward a charitable cause.
